If entered for the BOB in the open, these points should be claimed.

Guide To Title Rosettes/AGM Trophy Points System

1. AGM trophies and title rosettes/certificates are eligible to all fully paid up members for their Ragdolls/Household Pets/Pedigree Pets that they show at GCCF shows.
2. To qualify, you must be a fully paid up member when the awards are presented at the TBRCC AGM.
3. To claim a rosette and certificate for your cat gaining its title during the show year, please complete the 'Title Claim Form' document. There is no requirement to send copy certificates. All claims will be checked against GCCF title records on the GCCF website. You do not have to compete in the Trophy Points System to claim your award if you do not wish to. Please send all claims to the AGM Awards Secretary for titles gained before 31st December of each year to arrive no later than 31st January each year.
4. The trophy points system show year runs from 1st January until 31st December. You can only claim for a maximum of ten shows. Claim for your best ten shows. Only points claimed on the 'Trophy Points Forms' will be eligible for AGM Trophies.
5. If your cat is entered into more than one 'open', you can only claim points for one 'open'. i.e. If you win an Imperial certificate and a Grand certificate you can only claim for one award. Please note that Best of Colour wins are always claimed.
6. From 1st Jan 2025, points cannot be claimed for miscellaneous side classes.
7. If your cat wins a BOV (Best of Variety/Section) award please claim 15 points, if it then goes on to win a higher award (Best in Show) do claim another 20 points. That way you are being rewarded for each stage up the ladder.
8. In the event of two or more cats having the same number of points, those won at TBRCC Championship Show will be the deciding factor in the award for Ragdoll of the Year.
9. There are special forms for Household and Pedigree Pets sections. Please do not include any registration details about any pedigree pets claiming points/awards. You must always use the pet name that you enter in shows under. No details as to colour/pattern/breed number or breeder. Where the breeder is known to the owner and they are a member of TBRCC, points will not go towards 'Breeder Of The Year' award. This is for cats in the Pedigree section only. Only cats in the Pedigree section can win Ragdoll Of The Year as they are classed as Ragdolls on their show entry. Points won in these sections do count towards 'Showman of the Year' and 'Newcomer to Showing' and 'Junior Showman of the Year' awards.
